ESF REPORTING PROJECT

- 22 Thematic Studies
- Background reports
- Summary fiches
- Sources: existing official documents
- Programming periods: 2000/2006 and 2007/2013
- Focus on ESF (not EQUAL)
- Studies focus on reporting/communicating achievements (not evaluations)
- Quantitative studies supported by qualitative information



ESF and Roma

- Lack of data on Roma in existing sources (official ESF documents)
- Difficulties in definition (recognition of Roma as an ethnic minority)
- Differences in policies addressing Roma communities and individuals
- Different approaches in ESF implementation for Roma in Member States
