Synergic links between the ESF and ERDF

- the Human Resources and Employment Operational Programme (OP HRE) & the Integrated Operational Programme (IOP)
- mutual cohesion and synergies based on the cooperation and mutual co-ordination of activities
- several principal co-ordination mechanisms, such as the Managing and Co-ordinating Comittee, the Working Group for the Issues of the Roma Minority etc.
- the main objective of synergic links: the comprehensive and interlinked system of assistance





Synergic links between the ESF and ERDF

- all relevant calls in both OPs are interlinked by a common objective: social inclusion of the socially excluded people/Roma
- the same activities and social services are promoted and financed within the calls of both OPs
- "hard" and "soft" projects combined: investment in the physical infrastructure are complemented with investments in human potential
- the IOP is also interlinked with "IPRM" (Municipality development integrated plan) -> premium points for projects included in "IPRM"





Social services

- the IOP (Call 03 and 06)
 - providing facilities for residential, outpatient and outreach services and other activities
- the OP HRE (Call 55)
 - individual projects of municipalities
 - providing support for selected residential, outpatient and outreach services and other activities aimed at the target group
- the applications within the OP HRE have to be connected with the projects within the IOP (i.e. facilities needs to be provided first)





Social entrepreneurship

- a very good example of synergies between both OPs
- "hard" and "soft" projects combined, one entrepreneurial plan co-funded by both OPs (maximum 200 000 EUR/applicant)
- there are the same:
- a) beneficiaries,
- b) applicants (natural/artificial person and NGOs),
- c) supported activities.
- the projects assessed by the same external evaluators as well as assessed during the same commission





Social entrepreneurship

 IOP (Call 08), OP HRE (Call 30) – support the creation and development of new business activities focused on social entrepreneurship and at the same time enabling socially excluded people or people at risk of social exclusion their integration in the labour market
